



ery hour spin our famous chocolate wheel.





Seniors Week is a great opportunity to recognise the wide-ranging contributions of older Western Australians to our state.

As Minister for Seniors and Ageing, I've witnessed first-hand the benefits of these events - not only for organisers and those who take part, but also for the wider commu-

Much of this year's program

has been made possible by the McGowan Government's Seniors Week 2022 Community Grants Program, coordinated by the Council on the Ageing WA with support from the Department of Communities.

I'm particularly excited for the WA Seniors Awards, delivered in partnership with the Department of Communities and Council on the Ageing WA.

These awards celebrate exceptional seniors and those working to improve the lives of older Western Australians.

Our work to enhance the lives of Seniors is ongoing.

Throughout the year, we've been developing the WA Seniors Strategy 2023-2033, which will support seniors to live their best lives.

To date, more than 2,000 people have made their voices heard through postcard surveys and consultation sessions, both over the phone and in person.

Their submissions will help shape the strategy, which is scheduled to be released in early 2023.

Earlier this year, more than 310,000 Western Australian seniors took advantage of the State Government's Cost of Living Rebate, with WA Seniors Card members

sharing in almost \$26 million in ben-

These payments help to ease the financial strain of daily living expens-

In response to community feedback, the WA Seniors Card Discount Directory is once again available in hard copy.

This program provides members with a fantastic array of discounts and specials all year round; It's even better value if combined with a Commonwealth Seniors Health Card or Pensioner Concession Card, with annual discounts worth up to \$650.

Since its re-launch in August 2021, payments made to seniors under the State Government's Safety and Security Rebate scheme have passed the \$5 million mark.

WA seniors make a rich and diverse contribution to our state. In supporting seniors together, we are all supporting healthier communities, which benefits us all.

Seniors Week 2022 is for all Western Australians, of all ages, so I encourage everyone get involved.
